MINUTES - 7 April 2021

Minutes of Dethick, Lea and Holloway Parish Council meeting held by video conference on Wednesday 7 April 2021.

3952. To receive apologies for absence - None

3953. To consider motions for variations of business - None

3954. Declaration of member's interests at meeting

Councillor Stevenson declared a personal interest in Item 29 – Payments (Cheque 2660) and indicated that she would remain in the meeting but not participate in any discussions or vote.

3955. Public Speaking

A resident spoke about allotment provision and the difficulty in obtaining a plot in the area. The resident asked if the parish council would consider asking DCC/AVBC to pass on details of waiting list numbers to central government to get the conversation going. Garden space has been offered and this has been taken up.

A representative from Crich PPG Holiday Club gave background and information about the holiday club. There has been take-up from DLH children, but figures are not available as yet. There was some uncertainty as to whether information was passed on to children/parents at Lea Primary School.

The architect dealing with a potential planning proposal for two dwellings adjacent to Waterworks House on Lea Main Road gave background and information about the proposed development. It was highlighted that the Neighbourhood Plan does not rule out the right type of development. A highway consultant has been employed to deal with any access issues. Materials have not yet been agreed.

A representative from 20's Plenty described the campaign, which would see villages and towns throughout Derbyshire being made 20mph zones. Although this is not supported by Derbyshire County Council, it is supported by the current Derbyshire

Police and Crime Commissioner, the PCC Conservative candidate and the Chief Constable of Derbyshire Police.

3958. Chair's Announcements

Cllr McDonald was thanked for dealing with the grave markers, Cllr Stevenson was thanked obtaining grit and refilling the grit bins and Cllr O'Neil was thanked for carrying out the play area inspections.

At the Chair's forum in March, it was announced that Supt. Keen has become the Police representative for neighbourhood issues in Derbyshire and has joined the DALC Committee. The main issues flagged up are speeding and road safety, antisocial behaviour and lack of police visibility, rural wildlife and heritage crime and support for victims of crime.

A final decision on whether the parish council can return to having face-to-face meetings has not yet been made. More information will hopefully be available at the next meeting.

3959. Consider request from resident for allotment provision within the parish

RESOLVED: Defer a decision until it is known how many DLH children are participating in the scheme.

3961. Consider supporting the 20's Plenty for Derbyshire in its calls for 20mph as normal for settlements in Derbyshire

RESOLVED: To support the 20's Plenty campaign in its calls for 20mph in settlements in Derbyshire.

3962. Consider approaching John Smedley Ltd to ascertain whether the football pitch could be maintained and used by the community – Cllr O'Neil

RESOLVED: To approach John Smedley Ltd to ascertain whether their football pitch could be maintained and used by the community.

3963. Consider re-advertising the parish councillor vacancy and agree deadline date

RESOLVED: To re-advertise the vacancy with a deadline of the end of May and applications to be considered at the June PC meeting.

3964. To consider parish council insurance quotations

RESOLVED: To accept the 5-year agreement quotation from Zurich.

3965. Consider response to boundary review consultation - CIIr Ward

RESOLVED: To authorise Cllr Farnsworth to put together comments on behalf of the parish council.

3966. Street name signs in poor condition - Chapel Lane and Yew Tree Hill, Holloway – Cllr Crossley

RESOLVED: For the clerk to report the signs to AVBC.

3967. Yew Tree planning enforcement update – Cllr Crossley

Cllr Crossley explained that AVBC submitted a planning enforcement notice, but the planning inspectorate said it had not been submitted correctly. The representative from CAMRA made repeated requests for it to be re-submitted. However, AVBC eventually said that they were not going to re-submit the notice because it was out of time and also, because the landlady had been living in the public house for more than 4 years, she was within her rights to apply for change of use to a domestic dwelling. As a result of how AVBC had dealt with this enforcement notice, concerns were raised regarding the SHELAA and other planning matters.

3968. Consider a nomination for the Derbyshire Beacon of Hope Awards – Cllr Crossley

RESOLVED: To nominate DLH Community Support Group for an award.

3969. Consider memorial seat found in Receiving House – Cllr Stevenson

RESOLVED: To make the seat safe and install it in the cemetery.

3970. Consider additional defibrillator sign outside the Florence Nightingale Memorial Hall – Cllr Stevenson

RESOLVED: To proceed with the additional defibrillator sign on the wooden cladding outside the Florence Nightingale Memorial Hall.

3971. Consider disposal of memorial parts that have been left behind in the cemetery – Cllr Stevenson

RESOLVED: To store the stones inside the Receiving House and dispose of them if they are not claimed.

3972. Consider how to use remaining funds from Community Leadership Fund grant for Florence Nightingale Project (£129.28)

RESOLVED: To use the funds for plants and the defibrillator sign.

3974. Update - Climate Change Working Group - Cllr Crossley

Cllr Crossley confirmed that the questionnaires are coming in and the results will be analysed to see what people want to see and their priorities..

3975. Update - Installation of a basketball hoop at Lea recreation ground Lea Rec & Play Area Working Group

Cllr O'Neil confirmed that the issue has been obtaining quotes for the groundwork. Two quotes have been received, but queries have been raised on one of these. A response is requested. A company called Lightmain has visited the site and it appears that the installation may not be as easy as first thought due to ground water. They have not yet provided a quote. Cllr Stevenson explained that groundwater and getting materials and equipment on site could be an issue. A further update will be given at the May meeting.
