#### **Notes**

- 1. New lawn graves will only be available to parish residents with effect from effect from 1/1/26.
- 2. The definition of a parish resident is someone who lives in the parish, or who would have continued to live in the parish, but was obliged to live elsewhere for reasons of ill-health (e.g. moved to a care home).
- 3. A parish resident who has reserved a burial plot and subsequently moves out of the parish, for reasons other than ill-heath, will incur all subsequent charges at the 'Non-Parish Resident' rate.
- 4. Payments should normally be made by electronic transfer (Bacs). Cheques are to be made payable to 'Dethick Lea and Holloway Parish Council'.
- 5. Fees do not include the digging of the grave.
- 6. For Lawn Graves the full plot size will be 1.2m wide, with a maximum length of 2.4m.
- 7. For Cremated Remains plots the plot size is 600mm wide x 300mm deep.
- 8. Approval must be obtained from the Parish Clerk before burial or memorial work is undertaken.
- 9. Refer to Cemetery Regulations for further information.
