Notes

1. New lawn graves will only be available to parish residents with effect from effect from 1/1/26.
2. The definition of a parish resident is someone who lives in the parish, or who would have continued to live in the parish, but was obliged to live elsewhere for reasons of ill-health (e.g. moved to a care home).
3. A parish resident who has reserved a burial plot and subsequently moves out of the parish, for reasons other than ill-health, will incur all subsequent charges at the 'Non-Parish Resident' rate.
4. Payments should normally be made by electronic transfer (Bacs). Cheques are to be made payable to 'Dethick Lea and Holloway Parish Council'.
5. Fees do not include the digging of the grave.
6. For Lawn Graves the full plot size will be 1.2m wide, with a maximum length of 2.4m.
7. For Cremated Remains plots the plot size is 600mm wide x 300mm deep.
8. Approval must be obtained from the Parish Clerk before burial or memorial work is undertaken.
