We're sharing the latest news about our work to repair the Leashaw landslip.

## **Contractor appointed to undertake landslip repairs**

Following an extensive competitive tendering exercise, we're very pleased to be able to let you know that CT Construction Limited has been appointed to carry out the major repairs to the Leashaw landslip.

The contractor, based at Chinley in the High Peak, has worked on a number of previous Derbyshire County Council projects including the River Noe retaining wall reinstatement and ground stabilisation works on the A6187.

Subject to good weather conditions, initial preparations are expected to start in early July, with a secure compound created for the site office, welfare cabins and the storage of equipment and materials.

Work is then expected to start in late July on the site clearance works, creating access ramps on the slope for machinery and equipment to be able to get to work.

The repairs are expected to take up to 20 weeks, until approximately November this year, subject to any unexpected issues on site and good weather conditions.
